


Figure 3: ToC for Fight Against Gender-based Violence and Women Empowerment

IF GBV Programme targets Boys and Men with awareness campaigns and training that educates them about the negative effects of patriarchy on society AND actively participate in awareness raising campaigns and other educational programme. IF communities are involved in dialogues focused on responsible drinking and the dangers of substance abuse AND encourage Boys and Men to participate and lead the efforts to fight genderbased violence and femicide, this will lead to Boys and Men taking action to prevent GBVF and report cases to law enforcement agencies. IF communities establish community forums and use these to conduct training and local youth participate in sports and other educational, motivational entertainment AND are provided with opportunities for training and skills development, THEN there will be a positive change in behaviour and attitude of Boys and Men against women and other vulnerable groups which will lead to women and girl children safe from violence and abuse
